At Archgola™, we believe in creating outdoor living spaces that are tailored to your individual needs. That's why every Archgola™ canopy is custom designed to maximise your outdoor living space. With a wide range of roof tints and approximately 50 Dulux colours to choose from for your powder-coated frame, your Archgola™ will be uniquely yours.

Our Archgola™ frames and fittings are crafted using only the best quality pre galvanised steel sourced from New Zealand, along with aluminium. The combination of these provides exceptional strength to withstand the country's unpredictable weather patterns. Our design criteria adhere to Building Code NZ3604 (IL1) and are in alignment with AS/NZ1170 Structural Design Standards, which are certified by independent structural engineers.



To minimise corrosion and add durability, we apply a two step powder coat system to our pre-galvanised steel. Our powder coating system resists chipping, scratching, and wear, ensuring the frame remains highly resistant to moisture/corrosion creep if damaged. We recommend regular cleaning to maintain the longevity of the frame. Hot dip galvanised finish will be supplied if the property is located in a corrosive environment or near the coast.

It is known for its traditional look and exceptional strength, making it a perfect addition to any front porch or back deck. The arch shape also provides extra height, creating a unique and special feeling in the covered space.

The Signature canopy is a great choice for areas that do not fit the standard rectangle canopy format, and it comes with a choice of arched, bullnose or flat roofing profiles.

The canopy is constructed with powder-coated pre-galvanised NZ steel and Greca polycarbonate sheets, making it a reliable addition to your property. The Laserlite® Greca roofing has up to a 30-year warranty and provides easy care and 99.9% UV protection in a range of tints to choose from.



For a modern and sleek look, the Archgola™ Oasis canopy is designed to reflect the clean lines of modern NZ architecture. With a mono-pitch profile and polycarbonate roofing, the Oasis is perfect for those seeking a wide open covered space.

Constructed with a combination of powder-coated pre-galvanised NZ steel, zinc cast brackets, high-quality aluminium, premium 5mm polycarbonate sheet and stainless steel fasteners, the Archgola™ Oasis canopy is built to last!

Strong and Elegant

Designed to withstand New Zealand's harsh weather conditions, the Archgola™ Oasis is built with a combination of aluminum and steel. Our zinc cast brackets provide strength, toughness, and rigidity, while our two-step powder-coating process creates a high aesthetic level of finishing. Aluminum beams are lightweight and corrosion-resistant, making them ideal for our beam design. And our pre-galvanised steel posts and rafters provide strength and reliability, ensuring that your Archgola™ Oasis is a long-lasting addition to your property.



Beam Options

When choosing the size of the beam for your outdoor canopy, it's important to consider both the aesthetic and practical aspects of the decision.

The Archgola™ Oasis canopy offers a choice of a 135mm beam or a 200mm beam for the outside finish of the structure.

A 135mm beam has a streamlined appearance and is a good choice if you want a more subtle and understated look for your canopy. The narrow beam with more posts will be recommended if you are considering adding blinds in the future.

A 200mm beam is wider and more substantial in appearance, giving the canopy a bolder and more impressive look. It's a good choice if you want to make a statement with your canopy or if you have a larger canopy.

Fixing Options

Outdoor canopies can be attached to a building in a variety of ways, including soffit fixing and face fixing.

Soffit fixing involves attaching brackets to the underside of the building's soffit, which is the horizontal surface beneath the eaves of a roof.

Face fixing involves attaching the canopy to the face of the building, usually using brackets or posts that are bolted directly to the building's facade. Face fixing to the building's façade is dependent on the building to be strong enough to support the weight of the canopy.

Frame Colour

Archgola™ guarantees the powder-coated finish to remain in good condition for five years from the completion of construction, provided that the product care guidelines are followed.

Cantilevered

To increase the depth of shade needed in sunny spots, you can have the Archgola™ Oasis roofline cantilevered past the outside beam and posts.

Archgola™ Oasis Roof Tints

The Archgola™ Oasis canopy features a 600mm wide, high-quality 5mm polycarbonate roofing available in three tints, each with unique benefits to suit your preferences:

Protected by Clariant CESA Light UV and Light Stabilizers, the roofing sheet blocks 99.5% of UV rays (290-400 nm wavelength), minimizing damage from sunlight and heat, ensuring a long-lasting roofing solution.

With impact resistance 250 times greater than glass and 10 times more than FRP and Acrylic sheets, the Oasis polycarbonate sheets are tough and durable. It is important to be aware that polycarbonate roofing does scratch, and proper care when cleaning is required to minimise any damage.



Bronze Tint

Ideal for those who'd prefer high visibility, year-round, day and night.



Opal Tint

Ideal for those who'd prefer less glare and low light penetration.



Blue/Grey Tint

Ideal for those who'd prefer year-round, day and night high visibility as well as heat reduction.

With the right shape selected the canopy blends seamlessly into the house.

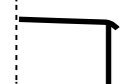
All four roofline options can be considered, depending on your setting, protection requirements, and personal taste.



Arched

Our classic arched shape is where it all began. The super strong, traditional Archgola™ look suits most house styles, enhancing the front porch or the back deck. It's not just the extra strength that customers like with the arch, it's the extra height you gain that makes the space feel special.

Arched shelters work well on a hipped house where the arch can follow the same lines – becoming an extension of what's already there.



Bull-nose

The bull-nose is a fusion between style and functionality, the roof line is straight with a slight arch at the end.



Cantilevered

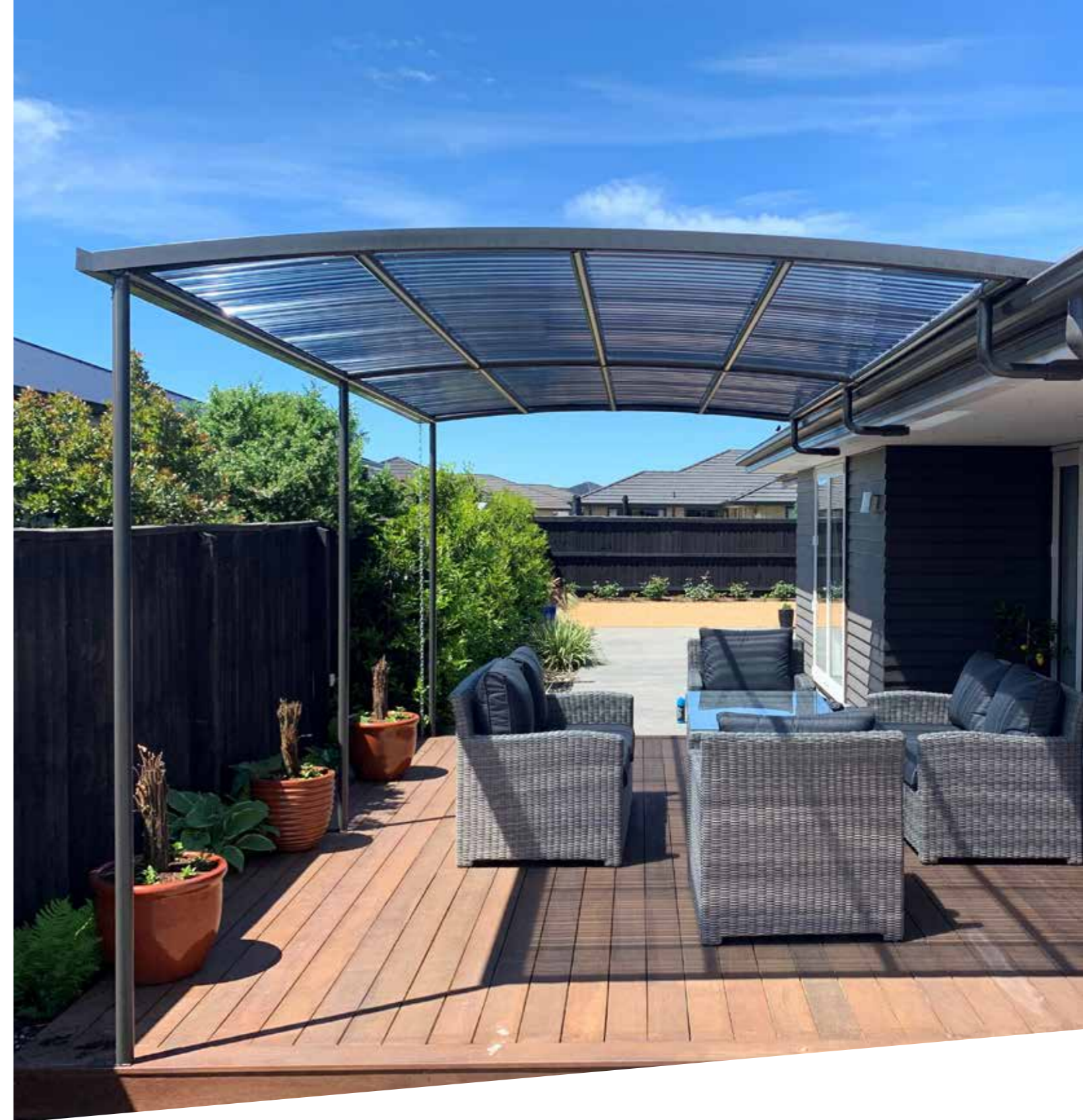
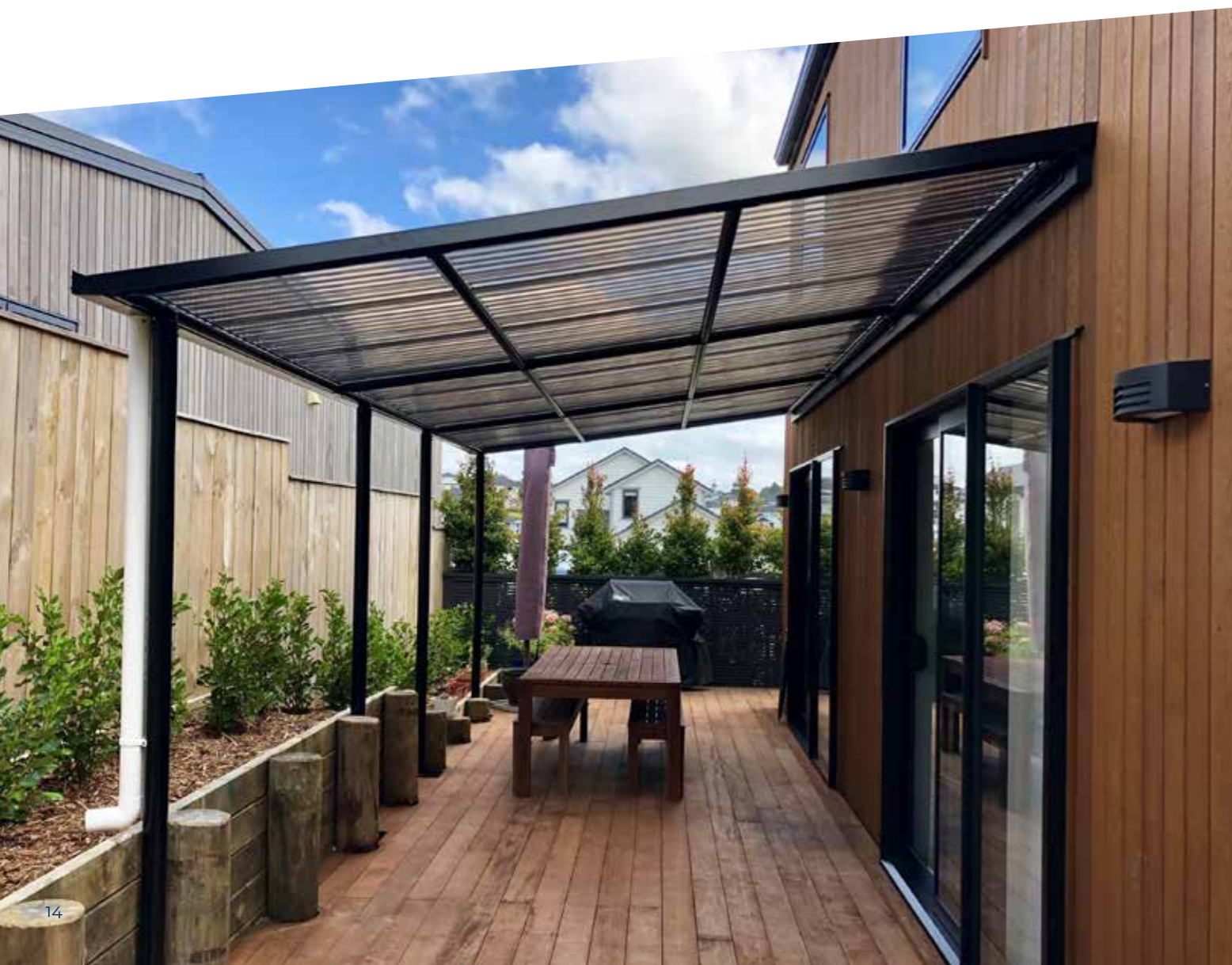
To increase the depth of shade needed in sunny spots, our cantilevered Archgola™ roofline, has an additional overhang past the posts, which can be included with either the straight or classic arch shape.



Straight

With a mono-pitch house, or where the decking is at the gable end a straight/flat canopy may suit best.

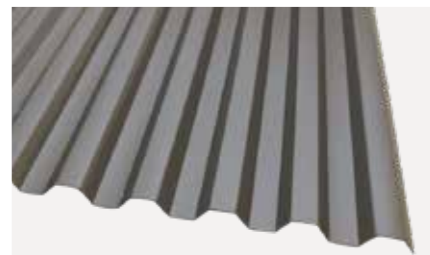
Laserlite® protects you from harmful UV rays, only transmitting beneficial radiation. It also blocks ultraviolet rays and resists rain, hail and extreme temperatures. Available in five different tints, allowing for varying degrees of light to filter through. If you’re installing an Archgola™ close to trees on your property, consider a roof tint that allows more light to come through.

If you want your Archgola™ to provide shade in a sunny spot, then a darker tint will let less light through and reduce glare.

Laserlite 3000 Comfort Cool™ Technology: Special properties in the sheet reflect the warming effect of the sun’s rays offering up to 50% better heat reduction than standard polycarbonate sheet* and reduced glare for ultimate comfort.

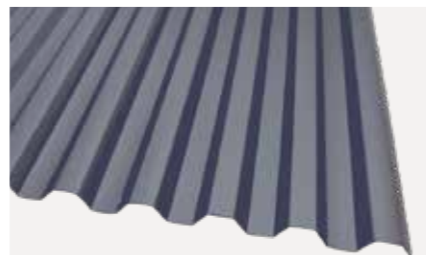

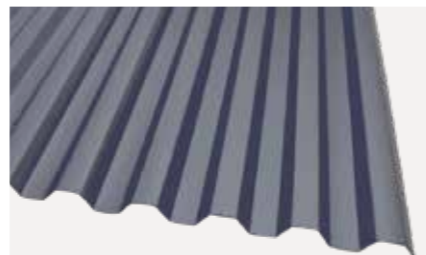

We use only the best quality New Zealand sourced steel to manufacture our Archgola™ steel frames and fittings.

Our design criteria meets Building Code NZ3604 (IL1) and is aligned with AS/NZ1170 Structural Design Standards. Design methods are certified by an independent structural Engineer. Each frame provides the stability and structure to ensure your Archgola™ is built to last.

Each pre-galvanised steel frame is connected with a unique series of specially designed fittings to ensure maximum strength whilst maintaining an attractive finish.

For additional protection we offer a Hot Dip galvanised option. This is essential for our clients with a coastal property to ensure protection from the corrosive sea air.

We offer two Outdoor Blind solutions, the Archgola EziGuide™ blinds and Ziptrak® blinds. Both are excellent options for outdoor blinds. Your choice will ultimately depend on your specific needs, preferences, and budget. Consulting with a licensed Archgola™ installer can help you determine the best option for your particular space and requirements.

If you have an existing outdoor structure, we can retrofit outdoor blinds to suit your needs.

Fabric Choice

Archgola EziGuide™ blinds and Ziptrak® use a range of high-quality, UV-resistant fabrics to provide shade and privacy.

Choose from either mesh, allowing you to enjoy the view but also enjoy a level of privacy and reduced glare on bright days, or clear PVC, strengthened by a 90mm polyester weave border.

The Mesh fabrics come in a variety of colours and weaves, allowing you to choose a style that complements your outdoor space. Mesh blocks out UV rays and heat and keeps wind* and rain at a minimum. Available in a full range of designer colours, to coordinate or contrast with your outdoor finishes. Ziptrak® sunscreen mesh blinds can also be motorised.

Clear PVC options allow you to enjoy your outdoor space while still providing protection from the elements.

Wind Resistance

Both Archgola EziGuide™* blinds and Ziptrak® blinds are designed to be wind-resistant, this means that your outdoor space will remain protected from the elements. Ziptrak® blinds patented track system helps to keep the blind fabric taut and in place, even in windy conditions. *It is recommended to roll blinds up in high winds. Blinds must not be left down in strong winds.

Archgola EziGuide™ blinds and Ziptrak® blinds are both popular options for outdoor blinds that provide shade, privacy, and protection from the elements.





Protection from the Elements

Our quality blinds and fittings are designed to withstand New Zealand conditions and come with a two-year warranty for the blinds and gearbox. The aluminium channel and powder coating have a five-year warranty.

ARCHGOLA EZIGUIDE™ BLINDS

Archgola EziGuide™ blinds are manually operated and attached to vertical side rails that guide the fabric along the track. They are easy to operate, with the option of using a winder or pull stick to raise and lower the blinds. These are custom designed to fit the Archgola™ Signature canopy and can be custom-made to fit non-standard spaces.

Perfect Outdoor Blind System

We've kept our outdoor blinds simple – there are no buttons, zips, or clips. Instead, two aluminium channels position the blinds perfectly.

Once wound down and tensioned, gaps are eliminated to prevent unwanted draughts. Our EziGuide™ blinds come with stainless steel fittings and a unique locking system, providing you with quality in both appearance and performance.

ZIPTRAK® OUTDOOR BLINDS

Ziptrak® blinds are operated by a spring-balanced system, which allows the blind to be easily opened and closed. To open or close the blind, simply grab the bottom rail and slide it up or down the track. The spring-balanced system makes it easy to do this with just one hand. When you release the bottom rail, it will stay in place wherever you left it, thanks to the tension created by the spring system. Ziptrak® suits the square posts of the Archgola™ Oasis canopy, and can be used on Archgola™ Signature canopies, when a square post has been installed. Ziptrak® sunscreen mesh blinds can also be motorised.



ARCHGOLA™ WARRANTY

We are proud to have over 25 years experience manufacturing and installing canopies. Providing the ongoing Archgola™ product care guidelines are strictly adhered to, all materials used in the construction of the canopies carry a five year warranty.

We use the highest quality steel, formed in our own precision tube mill and fabricated in our own factory, so you can be assured that the structure is built to last. This is backed by warranties on workmanship, frame and roofing materials (provided care guidelines are adhered to).

Archgola™ guarantees the powder coated finish on your Archgola™ will remain in good condition for a period of five years from the completion of construction if you observe the product care guidelines. Hence if you look after your Archgola™ it will look as good after five years, as it did the day it was installed.

Archgola™ canopies exposed to sea spray require higher levels of maintenance to honour this warranty. Please discuss this with your local installer.

Installation Warranty

All products installed by Archgola™ carry a 5 year workmanship warranty from the date of invoice.

Laserlite® Roofing

Your Laserlite® Roofing comes with two warranties. A 30 year warranty against loss of light and transmission and a 16 year warranty against weather breakage.

Archgola™ Oasis Polycarbonate Roofing

The Archgola™ Oasis polycarbonate roofing comes with two warranties. A 25 year warranty against loss of light and transmission and a 15 year warranty against hail breakage.

EziGuide™ Outdoor Blinds

EziGuide™ Outdoor Blinds have a 24 month warranty from the date of installation on blinds and the gear box, plus a 5 year warranty on aluminum channel and powder coating.

Ziptrak® Outdoor Blinds Ziptrak®

Ziptrak Pty. Ltd. provides a 24 months warranty on all the components of the Ziptrak® system.
